SCHOOL COUNCIL

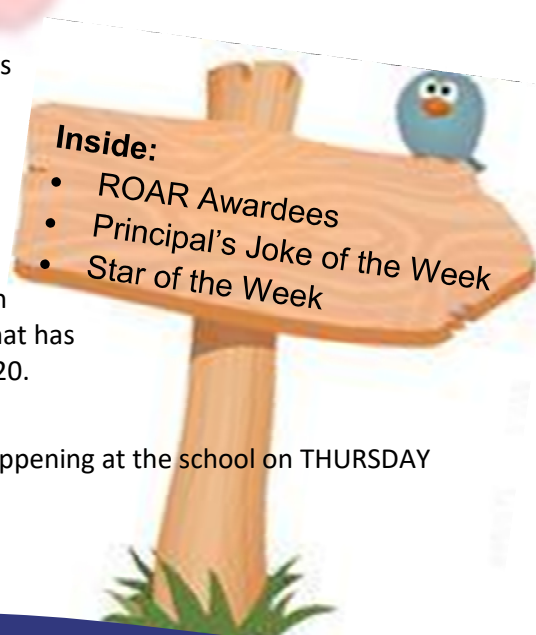

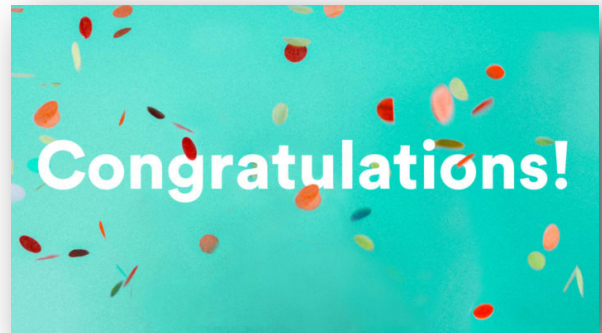
Classroom News:

The concert preparation has been going well with the students learning the songs we are singing and even dancing really well.

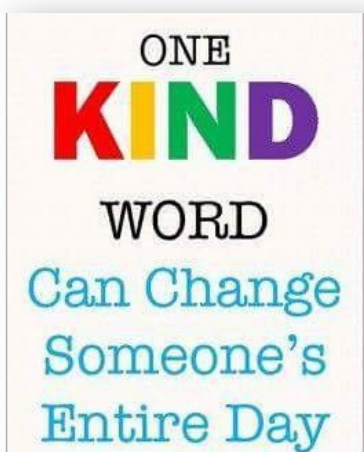
Our numeracy has also been consolidated with some outstanding leaps forward this year.

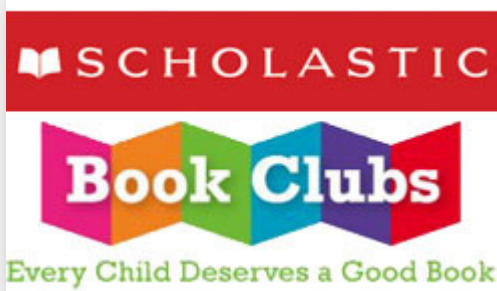
