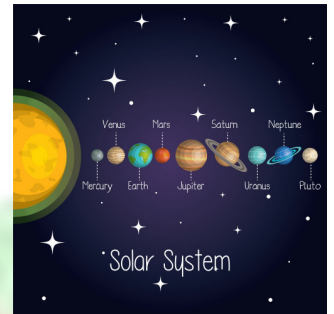
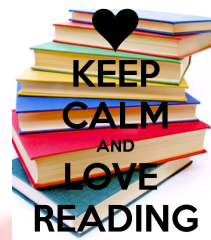
## Classroom News:

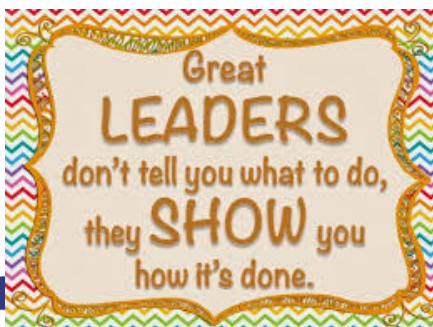

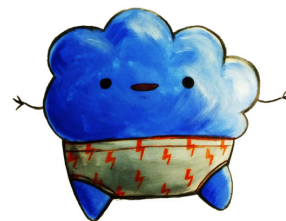

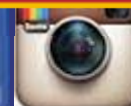
