#### **OUTDOOR SPACE**

As you would be aware, over the break work has continued on the buildings upgrade with the project moving forward in the development of the schools outdoor learning space. This outdoor school design provides flexible, high quality and environmentally sustainable educational facilities that supports the learning of all students. Consultations with the builders and the Victorian Schools Building Authority over the past fortnight have been rigorous with timelines in place in fastening work completion impacted by the pandemic. We will definitely be celebrating the completion of this project in the near future.

#### **CURRICULUM FOCUS ACROSS THE SCHOOL**

Over the term students will be investigating Living and Non-Living things as a Science focus area of study linked to the development of the "Kids Kitchen Garden". The students during semester one have concentrated on the design and development of the garden project. The next step is to link activities with the 'Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden Program' with opportunity for parents and wider community members to participate in activities incorporating seasonal planting in preparations for kitchen activities and food preparation. I welcome you to contact any staff member if you have an eager interest in assisting this exciting redevelopment.
