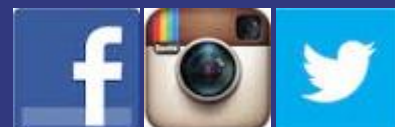

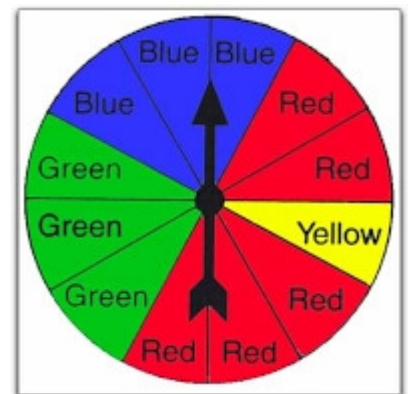
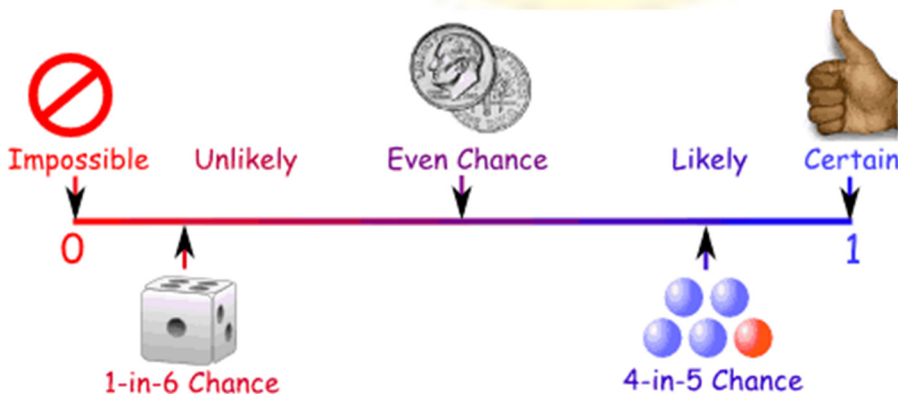
From the Classroom
