Jedd has started the year off brilliantly and has made some excellent choices this week. He is dedicated to his learning and always tries his best. Great work Jedd!


Jackson has settled into our Awesome Ardmona School Community really well and has already made some great friends. It is great to have you in our class and our school Declan! Keep up the great work!
