Classroom News:

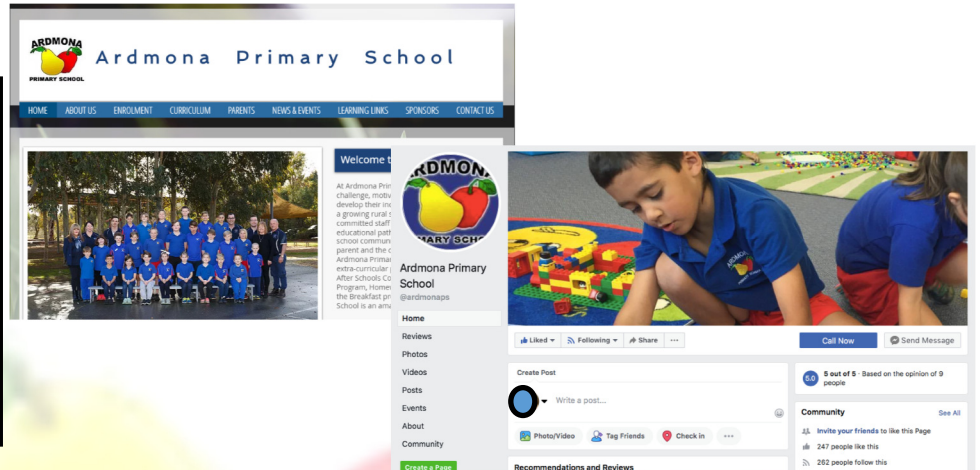
Grade 4-6: Welcome to Term 3 everyone! This week in literacy we have started practicing our reading strategy of reading aloud and also procedural writing.
