STUDENT LED CONFERENCES

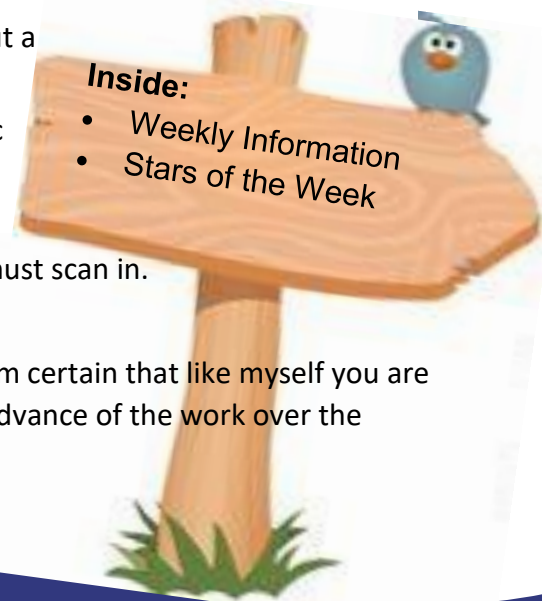

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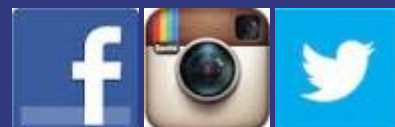
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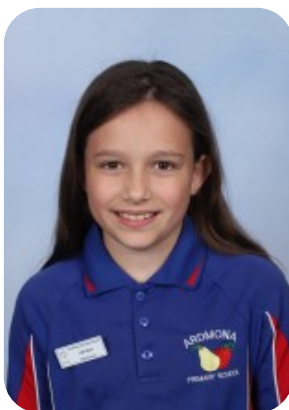
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AWESOME ARDMONA AWARD

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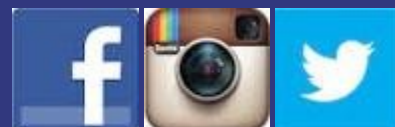
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STUDENT WEEKLY UPDATE REPORT

Thank you Jedd and we look forward to many more weekly updates in semester 2.



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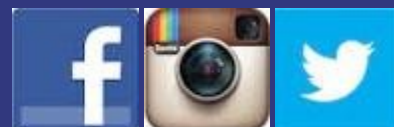

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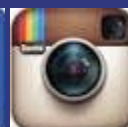

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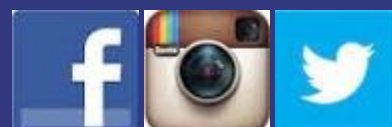
